We conducted 12 youth consultations on migration-related questions: 6 at the global level, 3 in Africa, 2 in Asia-Pacific, 1 in Latin America. In total, we consulted:

POLICY PROCESSES INFLUENCED



MYCP brought youth voices to national and international migration policy processes and delivered remarks at 30 sessions, conferences, and meetings. Thanks to the support of our partners, over 50% of our interventions were delivered in person. In 2022, we facilitated in person youth participation at:

ATTENDING EVENTS IN PERSON IS ESSENTIAL

Our past experience has shown that it is crucial for youth to be *present in the room*. Whilst engaging online allows for fulfilling a speaking position or taking the floor, it provides barriers to serving in facilitation or moderation roles, and also prevents any engagement with States and Stakeholders on the margins - excluding youth from important strategic conversations.
