HOW-TO CONTACT THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON CITIZENSHIP AND IMMIGRATION CANADA



Purpose

This document is intended to provide information on how to contact the Standing Committee on Citizenship and Immigration within the House of Commons of the federal government of Canada.

Background information

The <u>House of Commons in Canada</u> is made up of Members of Parliament (MP) who are elected officials from each provincial or territorial constituency in Canada. The size of a constituency and how many MPs represent a province or territory depends on the size of the population determined through the <u>Representation Formula</u>.

The MPs are divided into various committees on different public policy issues, which are renewed annually at every parliamentary session. Each committee is responsible for overseeing one or more government departments. Their tasks range from reviewing legislation, departmental operations, expenditures and evaluation of the effectiveness of the departments' policies and/or programs, including general referrals from the House of Commons.
